**Statutory Provision**

There is very little specific statutory support specifically for ex-Armed Forces personnel.

The Council is not under a legal duty to provide emergency accommodation for everyone who is sleeping rough.  
**General Rules.** Priority need is given to those with children or pregnant, minors and those considered on an individual basis to be vulnerable (eg: mental health problems).

**SHORE**

Have created temporary Pop Up Hubs to provide rapid identification and multi-agency intervention to tackle rough sleeping. They provide short bursts of intensive activity, targeting known hot spots and offer people access to mainstream services. Based in Eastbourne Borough Council, 01323 415393

**Extra allowances for Ex-Armed Forces.**

A Council may consider a person to be vulnerable as a result of having served in the Armed Forces. They may consider: Length of service, role and discharge date, anytime spent in a military hospital or if you had a Medical Discharge (with proof).

Each Councils Housing Options Team offer advice and support to rough sleepers. Most require an interview at their offices.
